Digital Photography Workflow

1. Save your photos/files

- a. On location
 - 1. DSLR Portable hard drive with an inbuilt SD card reader
 - 2. Smart phone USB phone photo backup thumb drive
- b. When you get home: DSLR & Smart Phone
 - 1. Tether camera/phone to your computer
 - 2. AirDrop Mac or Near By Share Android
 - 3. DSLR built in WIFI
- 2. Organize your photos/files with labels and folders
 - a. Scroll through and delete any duplicates and poor quality photos
- 3. Backup (make a copy of) your organized photo files
- 4. Edit your photos
- 5. Backup (make a copy of) your edited photo files
- 6. Copy individual backed up edited photos for distribution/sharing
- 7. Reformat and resize selected copied edited photos for distribution
 - a. Web and social media: JPEG 72ppi RGB
 - b. Digital photo printing: JPEG 300ppi RGB at dimensions of printed size
 - c. Commercial printing: TIFF 300ppi CMYK at dimensions of printed size
 - d. HD TV/Monitor: 1920 x 1080 pixels at 72 92ppi RBG JPEG
 - e. 4K TV/Monitor: 4096x2160 pixels 72-186ppi RGB JPEG
