As a Graphic Designer you will:

- Provide coaching, guidance, and direction to student business enterprises by helping the students create an appealing look for their business
- Attend one class to meet with student business owners (90 minutes) and do remote work (approximately 1-4 hours)
- Create a logo, business cards, marketing and promotional materials, and letterhead for 1-2 business groups

This experience has a significant impact on the students' ability to launch and run their own REAL, businesses or non-profit organizations.
